About The Program

The Defence Industry Leadership Program (DILP) is Australia's flagship leadership development program designed specifically for emerging and mid-career leaders across the defence sector.

Since 2010, DILP has helped develop more than 400 leaders from across industry, Defence, government and academia, creating a national network of professionals who contribute to the ongoing strength of Australia's defence sector.

Through a combination of facilitated learning, industry engagement, leadership coaching, applied learning experiences and peer collaboration, participants develop the leadership skills, confidence and broader industry perspective needed to lead with greater impact in their organisations and work effectively across a diverse range of stakeholders.

Unlike traditional leadership programs, DILP brings together participants from across the defence sector, creating opportunities to learn from different organisations, perspectives and experiences.

DILP is delivered over nine months through a combination of workshops, coaching sessions, site visits, field trips and applied project activities.

Graduates receive a nationally recognised Diploma of Leadership and Management through DTC's partnership with Skills Lab (RTO).

DILP develops leaders who can think beyond their own organisation, understand the wider defence sector and work effectively across the defence ecosystem.

DILP is designed for people who are ready to grow their leadership capability and broaden their understanding of the wider defence sector:

The DILP Experience Includes

- **Facilitated In-Person Workshops** - Develop practical leadership skills and strategies through eight interactive workshops delivered throughout the nine-month program
- **Industry Speakers** - Learn directly from senior Defence, government and industry leaders about the opportunities, challenges and realities shaping Australia's defence sector.
- **Leadership Coaching** - Build self-awareness, confidence and personal effectiveness through three individual and two facilitated group coaching sessions.
- **Site Visits** - Gain exposure to a range of defence industry, Defence and government environments, providing insight into how different parts of the sector operate and collaborate.
- **Canberra Immersion Experience** - Explore how government, policy, strategy and capability decisions influence Defence and industry through an overnight Canberra field trip.
- **Applied Group Leadership Project** - Work collaboratively on a simulated leadership challenge, applying learning throughout the program and presenting recommendations to an industry panel.
- **Peer Learning** - Learn alongside participants from Defence, government, primes, SMEs and academia, gaining insight into different perspectives and ways of working across the sector.

- Non-Member working or residing interstate: \$20,650 (+GST)

Course Eligibility (*)

To be eligible for the Government subsidised SA rate, participants must:

- reside or work in South Australia; and be an Australian or New Zealand citizen or a permanent Australian resident; or
- hold a State sponsored visa on a pathway to permanent residency; or
- hold a humanitarian temporary visa of a class specified by the Minister from time to time.

The course fee includes all course materials, catering at workshops, site tours, field trips [including 2 nights accommodation in Canberra], entry to networking events, graduation, Diploma of Leadership & Management, and a complementary ticket to the DTC's Defence Industry Dinner & Awards Ceremony in Adelaide.

Interest free payment plans are available.

Exclusions

- Airfares for any interstate field trips are not included in the course fee and must be covered separately by the participant.
- Interstate travel to participate in the program in Adelaide is at the cost of the participant.
