Before you submit your application online

The online application form does not have the functionality to save your progress, so we recommend that you prepare your application in advance, including the documents you will need to upload.



Your Application Questionnaire will include

- Your biography (200 words max)
- In your current role, or in a previous role, have you had direct reports? Y/N options
- Why do you want to do the DILP course? (200 words max)
- How will participation in DILP contribute to the organisation you work for? (200 words max)
- How can your participation in DILP benefit Australia's defence industry? (200 words max)
- What would you most like to learn from the DILP course? (200 words max)
- How did you hear about the DILP?
- For interstate applicants, do you undertake any work in South Australia? If yes, what percentage of your work is conducted in South Australia?

You will need to upload copies of your

- Current CV
- Current job description/PD
- Driver's license or Passport

National and Security Details

DILP Participants may visit secure facilities, so we need to know in advance if you have a clearance.

You will need to advise us:

- Australian Citizenship status
- The Visa type you hold if applicable
- Dual Citizenship status
- AGSVA Security Clearance status (Y/N options)
 - Find details about clearances at agsva.gov.au
- If you hold a Defence Common Access Card (DCAC)
 - Note, we do not require a copy of your DCAC card

DTC Member

- DTC Member working or residing in SA: \$10,400 ex GST*
- DTC Member working or residing interstate: \$18,000 ex GST

DTC Non-Member

- Non-Member working or residing in SA: \$11,445 ex GST*
- Non-Member working or residing interstate: \$19,445 ex GST

Course Eligibility (*)

To be eligible for the Government subsidised SA rate, participants must:

- reside or work in South Australia; and be an Australian or New Zealand citizen; or
- be a permanent Australian resident; or
- hold a State sponsored visa on a pathway to permanent residency; or
- hold a humanitarian temporary visa of a class specified by the Minister from time to time.

The course fee includes all course materials, catering at workshops, site tours, field trips, entry to networking events, graduation, Diploma of Leadership & Management, and a complementary ticket to the DTC's Defence Industry Dinner & Awards Ceremony in Adelaide.

Interest free payment plans are available.

Exclusions

- Airfares for any interstate field trips are not included in the course fee and must be covered separately by the participant.
- Interstate travel to participate in the program in Adelaide is at the cost of the participant.
