Guided Leadership Evolution - Leadership Coaching.

Course Eligibility (*)

To be eligible for the Government subsidised SA rate, participants

- reside or work in South Australia; and be an Australian or New Zealand citizen; or
- be a permanent Australian resident; or
- hold a State sponsored visa on a pathway to permanent residency; or
- hold a humanitarian temporary visa of a class specified by the Minister from time to time.
